6. Cancellations and No Shows

- 6.1 Drivers must respect the Company's cancellation policy and communicate any changes promptly.
- 6.2 No-show passengers should be reported to the Company, with relevant details provided.

7. Payment and Invoicing

- 7.1 Drivers shall receive payments according to the agreed terms and rates set by the Company.
- 7.2 Invoices submitted by Drivers must accurately reflect the services provided and comply with applicable tax regulations.

8. Data Protection

8.1 Drivers are required to handle passenger information with utmost confidentiality and comply with data protection laws.
