1. Definitions

Child: Any person under the age of 18.

Safeguarding: The process of protecting children from harm, ensuring their wellbeing, and taking measures to provide a safe environment.

2. Principles

Best Interests of the Child: The best interests of the child will always be the primary consideration in all actions and decisions.

Empowerment: Children will be actively encouraged to voice their opinions and concerns, and their input will be considered in matters that affect them.

Non-Discrimination: All children will be treated with respect and dignity, irrespective of their race, ethnicity, gender, religion, disability, or any other status.

3. Responsibilities

Designated Safeguarding Officer: Danyal Afzal will be appointed as the designated safeguarding officer responsible for coordinating safeguarding efforts and serving as the point of contact for any safeguarding concerns.

All Staff: All staff members are responsible for being vigilant, reporting concerns promptly, and cooperating with any investigations.

4. Recruitment and Training

All staff and volunteers working with children will undergo rigorous background checks, including Enhanced DBS checks.

Any concerns or suspicions regarding the welfare of a child must be reported immediately to the designated safeguarding officer.

The designated safeguarding officer will follow established reporting procedures and, if necessary, involve relevant authorities.
